

Briefly described, the *President* is the CEO of the Chapter and is the only designated, voting delegate to RPEA's <u>biennial General Assembly</u>. The *Vice-President* acts in the absence of the President and at the request of the President. The *Secretary* handles correspondence for the Chapter and takes and records the Minutes of Board and Chapter meetings. The *Treasurer* is assignatory on Chapter bank accounts; maintains financial records of the Chapter; prepares timely reports for the members; prepares reports for a yearly, financial review.
