Did You Know?

The Palace Saloon opened in 1877. Famous patrons included Wyatt Earp and Doc Holiday and his wife, Big nose Kate.

Virgil Earp became a deputy U.S. Marshall, operating out of Prescott.

On July 14, 1900, a fire started in a miners room around 10:30 p.m., that destroyed five city blocks, including all of the buildings on Whiskey Row. The patrons of the Palace picked up the bar, and the back bar, and carried them across the street to the Courthouse Square, and continued their drinking while watching the fire. Losses totaled over \$1,500,000. The Palace was rebuilt in 1901.

Several movies have been filmed in the Palace, including "Wish Man", the story of the founder of the Make-A-Wish Foundation, "Billy Jack", and "Junior Bonner", staring Steve McQueen and Ida Lupino.

The Palace has been voted one of the ten best restaurants and saloons in the country. The "Daily Courier" calls it the best Whiskey Row bar.
